# Volunteer Opportunities at Minooka Community High School

Volunteer opportunities vary according to interest, time commitment, and ability. The most important thing to remember, though, is that WE NEED YOUR HELP! If you would like to make a difference by becoming a volunteer at MCHS, please consider the volunteer options below:

## Athletic Boosters

- Officer positions
- Work concession stands to earn "shares" for your child's sport (cash in shares at the end of the year for money that goes to your child's sport)
- "All Sports Coaches Cookout" – fall kickoff program
- NASCAR event during summer (raises funds for Homecoming fireworks show)
- Time commitment – Monthly meetings; can work at any time throughout the year as much or as little as wanted

## Band Boosters

- Officer positions
- Uniform care/fitting/repairs
- Chaperoning trips
- Fund-raising
- Band Booster Committee
- Time commitment – Monthly meetings; can work at any time throughout the year as much or as little as wanted

## Choir Boosters

- Officer positions
- Special Event Chairpeople – Madrigal Dinner, Newsletter, Housewalk & Craft Show, etc.
- Chaperones – assist at home and away choral events to care for/supervise choral students.
- Fund-raising
- Time commitment – Monthly meetings; can work at any time throughout the year as much or as little as wanted

## Football Dinner Committee

- Organize, collect funds for weekly Thursday evening team meals
- Time commitment – Duration of football season

## Handbook Committee

- Parents may attend meetings with MCHS staff members and students to discuss changes to the rules/policies/discipline procedures for students
- Time commitment – Approximately three to five one-hour meetings

## Musical/Play Production

- Costumes
- Provide and serve an evening meal for the cast, crew, and pit orchestra during the last three weeks of rehearsals
- Fund-raising
- Assisting with special set construction and prop construction projects
- Time commitment – varies

## Post Prom

- Before event – build props for decorations
- Night of event – work booths; chaperone
- Ticket sales during lunches
- Time commitment – varies

## Parking Permit Sales

- Work with Deans' Office to sell parking permits to students at the beginning of school year
- Time commitment – varies

## Special Events/Special Groups

- Career day presenter (March)
- Guest speaker (by class/subject area)
- Focus groups, ad-hoc committees (as needed)
- Time commitment – varies
